What's on offer?

The course takes place both in-person and online.

In-person sessions run on **Wednesdays and Thursdays, 10am - 2pm** at Stockport Museum (Staircase House) in the town centre. (Map: <https://goo.gl/maps/1xUqqdWLB9A9fGbu9>).

Optional online sessions will take place on **Mondays and Fridays, 6pm - 8pm**. These will also be recorded for anyone who can't make it to catch up later.

Additional technical support is available through our online community platform, and you can request one-to-one support when needed with an expert mentor.

Who is this course for?

People who live in Stockport, aged 18 - 30 and not currently in full-time education.

We are especially looking to support those who are either unemployed or underemployed (e.g. on a zero-hours contract, or in a fast-food restaurant with unpredictable hours).

Complete beginners. Absolutely no coding experience is necessary, but you will need to be familiar with using a computer – for example to browse the internet, or to save and find files on your hard drive.

Someone who can make the commitment to attend the whole course. We strongly encourage you to attend every session but we will be available to help you catch up if you are unable to make 1-2 sessions due to prior commitments.

Those with access to a laptop or computer on which you have permission to install the software required for the course (i.e. not a mobile phone or tablet). If you only have a desktop computer at home, we can provide a laptop for in-person sessions.
